Duration : 2 Days / 1 Night

Activity : Min 8 Hours Rafting - 4 Hours Rafting per day

PROPOSED ITINERARY OVERVIEW :

Day One:

10:00 /10:30

Arrival at Camp – Sandwich and Fruit on arrival with juice

11:00

Safety Briefing – transport to PUT IN POINT - Paddling Begins

Paddling begins above Round The Bend Lodge – down river **[+/-2hours]**

13:30

Lunch – on river – students to prepare under supervision of guides.

14:30

Activity – Paddling Continues

Paddling continues from lunch towards Round The Bend Camp **[+/-2hours]**

17:30

Arrive at Round The Bend Camp - Freshen up – Prep for Dinner

19:00

Dinner – students to prepare under supervision of guides.

- ✚ “Reflection Time” – Students to complete Adventurous Journey Forms for day 1
- ✚ Guides to assess each Student – Students to hand over assessment books/sheets for Guides to complete.

Day Two :

06:30

Breakfast – students to prepare under supervision of guides.

08:30

Activity - Part Two Paddling

Paddling from Round The Bend down to Up The Creek camp **[+/-2hours]**

12:00

Lunch - on river – students to prepare under supervision of guides.

13:00

Activity – Paddling Continues

Paddling continues from lunch stop down towards Up The Creek **[+/-2hours]**

15:00

Arrive at Up The Creek Camp – Transport back to Round The Bend

16:00/17:00

Freshen Up – Wrap Up

TRIP NOTES OVERVIEW :

- All students will be required to carry all their own gear and assist with carrying meal gear and equipment
- Felix Guide Team will be on the trip to observe assist with regards to safety and wherever guidance is required with the various activities / tasks
- Felix Unite will supply all catering and catering equipment - All students will be involved in all food preparations/cleaning along with any camp set up requirements during their Adventurous Journey.
- Felix Unite will cater for specific dietary requirements – IE : Halaal, kosher, vegetarian, allergies etc

ACCOMMODATION – OPTION - OVERVIEW : ROUND THE BEND

OPTION ONE :

24 x Two Sleeper Thatched A-Frame chalets – en-suite bathroom

- Students to supply all their own sleeping bags, pillows and towels.
- Return Each night to Camp and stay in fixed accommodation

OPTION TWO :

Students to supply their own tents and they camp on the banks of the Beach Camp with shared ablutions

- Students to supply all their own sleeping bags, air mattresses, pillows and towels.
- Return Each night to Camp and stay in tents on bank of river at Beach Camp adjacent to Main Camp

Please note Chaperoning Teachers/Parents will get fixed accommodation with Linen and Towels they will not be required to camp or bring their own gear, this however is entirely up to them – Guides will oversee Students at night when camping or in chalets.
